About copyright protection

1. Copyright is governed by international agreements and national legislation (Berne Convention, World Copyright Convention, TRIPS). These agreements provide protection in accordance with national legislation for works created on the territory of other countries.

2. Any agreements that are concluded with users (performers) on the site must indicate who owns the intellectual property and which information should be treated as confidential. If this is not agreed upon, the buyer automatically becomes the owner of the work that the contractor handed over to him.

3. If you need more reliable protection than the disclaimer in the ad, you can use the user agreement.

4. The user (contractor) agrees to maintain the confidentiality of all information received within the framework of the project, as well as the buyer.

5. The buyer grants the user (contractor) limited rights to use any materials that he shares to perform the work defined in the announcement, but intellectual property rights remain. When the project is completed, the contractor deletes or returns the materials to the customer.

6. After full payment, the contractor does not retain the right to use the content, the created project becomes the property of the customer.

7. The contractor needs the buyer's permission to include the project in his portfolio.

If the rights indicated by the contractor in the announcement have been violated, then you should write a claim that should contain:

1. A description of what is protected by copyright, under the protection of intellectual property.

2. Scan, screenshot or file where the owner is specified.

3. An indication of who the applicant is in this case (the owner or representative).

4. Evidence of violation of property rights.

5. Specifying the username or username of the user who violated the right.

6. Indication of personal data for communication and clarification of details.

A competent and detailed description of the situation will help resolve the issue.

In case of confirmation of a violation of the right, the posted content will be blocked or deleted.

If the user cancels their claim, the moderators can restore the blocked or deleted content or account.

If a judicial procedure is conducted in connection with copyright violations, and Plandi.io is a participant and suffers any losses (reputation and finances), then the user may be held liable for losses.
